- 1 The Minutes of the Last Meeting held on the 1 March 2017 had been circulated prior to the meeting and were agreed, as a true record.
- 2 Matters Arising from the Minutes
  - a) **Easingwold Library**

M Turvey gave an update on the internal alterations to the Building. A grant of £5000 from HDC to help towards the Administration and Fixture costs. The official opening date is 18 April.
  - b) **Nicholas Church Yard Stillington**

The Contractor hopes to start the repair of the Head and Gravestones in mid-April. The delay in starting the work has been due to the weather.
  - c) **White Fencing Posts and Railings**

The work on 13 Fence posts have been completed and now that the weather is improving they will be painted in the next two weeks
  - d) **Emergency Co-ordinator for the Village**

Work is still on going producing a draft action plan for consideration

e) **Drainage Problems South Back Lane**

An on site meeting with NYCC was held to obtain a solution to resolve the on going problem. It was agreed to install a French drain on the verge in front of Croft and Lupin Houses.

Action is in hand to complete this work, at this stage it is not known when the work will be undertaken.

f) **Dog Fouling.**

Dog Fouling still remains a problem through out the Village. Additional Yellow paint will be purchased.

3) **Planning New**

a) Woodland Farm Moor Lane Stillington

Single Storey Rear Extension

There was no objection

4) Planning Agreed

a) Wren House High Street Stillington

Retention of satellite Dish to the rear of the dwelling

HDC agreed this application

b) Holly Garth North Back Lane

Work to Sycamore Tree in a conservation

HDC have agreed this application

c) The Folly High Street Stillington

Alterations and extension to existing outbuildings

HDC have agreed this application

5) **Development South Back Lane**

- a) The resurfacing of South Back Lane is expected to commence on 10 April and will continue for 4 days

b) **One- way system South Back Lane.**

NYCC are still in the process of obtaining the legal order to implement the changes. It is not known when this order will be completed

6) **Village Development Fund (Community Infrastructure Levy. ( C.I.L)**

There is no change in the current position; there are no funds in The Stillington Village account.

This situation will change in the future with commencement of Developments.

7) **Telephone Box. Main Street**

We continue to wait for Information from BT regarding the adoption of The Telephone Box. BT has a backlog of application requests and are trying to clear these as soon as possible.

8) **Parish Plan (Speeding in the Village 95 Alive (Community Speed Watch Scheme)**

The recent survey carried out has now been forwarded to NYPA Community Speed Watch Co-Coordinator for action. A note will be put into Stillington News for information

9) **Replacement Tree West Green and Village Green**

Suitable trees have now been identified and it is expected that they will be planted in Mid-April

10) **Community Payback Scheme (Formally known as Probation Community Service)**

It was agreed that M Rowe would co-ordinate the work in the Village

11) **Landscaping Village Hall**

The Plan for landscaping was agreed by the Parish Council

It has been established that Planning Permission is required and further discussions will be held with the Village Hall Committee to take the matter forward. Funding for the project from S106 monies would be explored with HDC

12)           **CPR Training**

It was agreed that B Smith and D Goodall were to seek a local source to this training.

13)   **Next Meeting**

The next monthly meeting will be on Wednesday 3 May and the AGM at 7.00pm on Wednesday 24 May 2017
