2 Matters Arising from the Minutes

a) **Easingwold Library**

b) **St Nicholas Church Yard Stillington**

The Contractor is hopeful he will finish the work on the Head and Grave stones by March 2017

c) **White Fencing Posts and Railings**

Work is continuing with replacement to fence. To date 7-fence posts have been replaced.

A village resident has volunteered to paint the new Fence posts. It was agreed to accept this kind offer

d) **Emergency Co-ordinator for Village**

It was agreed to have a co-ordinator as recommended

A note would be placed in Stillington News asking for volunteers to assist in this task

e) **Drainage Problems South Back Lane**

No further information available from Yorkshire Water/NYCC has been received.

NYCC is to investigate the problem again.

f) Dog Fouling.

The HDC Dog Warden had visited the Village on two occasions in the last month. Further discussion on this subject will be take place at February Meeting

4) Finance

a) Precept 2017/2018

It was agreed to seek a precept of £7500 for the Financial Year 2017/2018

5) Development South Back Lane

a) Agreement has now been reached between with NYCC, HDC and Daniel Gath on the replacement lighting in South Lane Back.

It is not known at this time when the new Lighting will be installed

b) On road Parking in South Back Lane was becoming a problem and it was agreed to seek further information from the developer as it was thought that there was some restrictions

c) One- way system South Back Lane.

No further information on this item was available.

6) Village Development Fund (Community Infrastructure Levy. (CIL)

The CIL access software is still not available.

7) Telephone Box Main Street

Suggestions for use are still requested, a note was placed in the Stillington News but to date there had been no ideas. A further note would be placed in the February Edition of the News

8) **Parish Plan (Speeding in the Village 95 Alive
(Community Speed Watch Scheme)**

The Village Speed Survey has been sent to the Community Speed Watch Scheme. An acknowledgement has been received and the results are being assessed
Thanks were expressed to residents who had helped with the survey

9) **Replacement Tree West Green**

Replacement Tree for the West Green in the Village will be re-sourced due to difficulty in supplying specific Tree.
The supplier will be contacted again

10) **Community Payback Scheme
(Formally known as Probation Community Service)**

After discussion it was decided that no immediate work was evident. This item would be left on the Agenda to discuss future work ie Clearing Paths, Litter Picking, Painting, or any other work in the future.

It was reported that a tree planted to commemorate the Millennium had died.
It was agreed that the PCC would replace the original with a suitable Tree
