2 Matters Arising from the Minutes

a) **Easingwold Library**

Work is ongoing in the production of a plan.

e) **Drainage Problems South Back Lane**

Agreed to remove at next meeting and review situation in October 2017

f) **Dog Fouling.**

Dog Fouling still remains a problem through out the Village.  
Yellow Spray paint is now available

3) **Planning New**

a) Wrens nest Bungalow York Road

Create new access and driveway

There was no objection

b) Land north of West Lane Stillington

Application for outline planning for the construction of a detached dwelling house.

We wish this application to be refused as it is outside the development areas off the Village

c) 1 South View High Street Stillington

Two storey rear extension and detached garage

There were a number of concerns that it was out of proportion to the location. effect on surrounding property and location of garage

4) **Planning Agreed**

a) Woodland Farm Moor Lane Stillington

Single storey rear extension to dwelling house too provide annex

HDC agreed this application

5) **Finance**

6) **Development South Back Lane**

One- way system South Back Lane.

Following the completion of the Resurfacing of South Back Lane NYCC have issued a works order for new signage for the one-way system from South Back Lane to Main Street. It was noted that the temporary signs were still in Place. NYCC will be asked to remove as soon as possible

7) **Village Development Fund (Community Infrastructure Levy. ( C.I.L)**

There is no change in the current position; there are no funds in The Stillington Village account.  
It was agreed to take this item off the Agenda until funds were available

8) **Telephone Box. Main Street**

BT have agreed to sell the Telephone Box to The Parish Council for £1.00. Action is now in hand to sign contract etc.

9) **Parish Plan (Speeding in the Village 95 Alive (Community Speed Watch Scheme)**

The Road Safety Partnership have decided they need further data to ensure that the right solution when dealing with matter for our community as part of this process they will install a covert monitoring equipment to measure the speed of vehicles using High street over the week long period (24 Hours a day) they will contact us again when the information has been analysed. to decide a way forward

**Replacement Tree West Green and Village Green**

Suitable trees have now been identified. However it was decided to leave the planting until the autumn when less maintenance would be needed i.e. watering the tree during the Summer

11) **Community Payback Scheme  
(Formally known as Probation Community Service)**

M Rowe has arranged a meeting with for the Community Payback Co-coordinator to agree path clearance routes and welfare facilities required for their work in the Summer of 2017.

12) **Landscaping Village Hall**

Further discussions will be held with the Village Hall Committee to finalise the proposed Landscaping and to cost the scheme some funding from S106 monies would be available.

13) **CPR Training**

CPR Training has been arranged for 6 and 13 June in Village Hall commencing at 7.30pm.

14) **HDC Local Plan Alternative Sites and Local Green space**
