7.2 Three Year Tree inspection for the Closed Parish Church Graveyard. A request for the cost of English Trees Co. to Survey all trees in the Old Church Graveyard is in hand.

7.3 Pond Project Update. Top Cut Tree services to take Contract for Tree works.

8. HIGHWAY ISSUES.

8.1 Pathway repairs are ongoing and High Street has been resurfaced and partial resurfacing of Easingwold Road entrance to village.

8.2 Awaiting a decision from NYCC for the decision on the cost of installing a new lamp post to be located at the junction of The Village Hall and the B1363 road, no progress due to working from home.

8.3 Trees to plant on York Road to replace ones removed in 2019. This work was scheduled to be undertaken during late 2019 and a budget of £1,700 was set aside at a previous meeting of the Parish council. (it is on the 2019 Precept). No decision. Suspended until restrictions are over due to the Pandemic.
