Stillington Parish Council Chairman's Report. 2018-19

The Parish Council has continued to meet during the 12 Months Pandemic. A back-to-back ZOOM Scheduled meeting was used which gave Two 40 Minute session to conduct business. This appears to work reasonable with some time adjustments after the first meetings. We invited several the public to connect to our meetings who had planning applications for various planning objects, this was successful and appreciated by the attendees who joined our ZOOM Video Meeting.

I can confidently confirm we have made some progress in Stillington Parish. During the year. 20/21

The Village Hall goes from strength to strength and a New Fire /Exit Door has been installed during the year. The Parish Council has awarded £2,000.00 from the C.I.L. Fund towards the Cost of Installation.

The Village Defibrillator

The Defib is now supported by a two year maintenance contract with money (£300.00) from the C.I.L fund. The Defibrillator is in the Parish Church Entrance Porch. The original Defib was maintained during the latter half of the year and was found to be up to Specification..

Close Graveyard Tree Survey.

A Tree survey within the Close Graveyard has revealed a number of Trees require pruning and crowning, it is hope that this will be carried out during the following Months. A full survey report is available on request to the Parish Clerk.

Closed Graveyard Headstone Testing.

The annual inspection of the Closed Graveyard Headstone Testing took place within the Pandemic Guidance, A quotation for work to Seven Headstone was requested and accepted by the Paris Council. A budget is available for this work.

They will be repaired when a Faculty (Permission to Work in the Graveyard) arrives from the Diocese office.

Mill Lane Npower Cables (replacement of supplies to Houses in Mill Lane and the East Green)

Confirmation of Npower are making a start on the replacement of the Overhead cable network along the North Side of the Eastern Village Green and down Mill Lane. They are replacing the overhead wires with underground cables which should make the supply more secure and provide for future demand.

The new financial years starts with a new Balance Sheet. Unfortunately, whilst we have not spent money on Physical work, we have spent money on three Estimates A) For the Pond Restructuring B) The Closed Church Graveyard Tree Survey in total £840.00.

For further Liabilities I have attached an assessment list for information.

May I thank all who have given so much during the Pandemic and congratulations on a job well done now that we possible have the Corvid-19 Virus situation under control. Especially to The Village Shop for their community support and application, To the people who have helped in the transportation of medical supplies to the Community.
